Mastersound™ is the CBS brand name for records and cassettes that incorporate all the latest advances in recording technology, and combine them with intensive quality control...quality control that is impossible with mass produced recordings.

Originally, Mastersound recordings were created for a select group of "audiophiles"...people who devote much of their time, money and energies attempting to electronically re-create the sound of live music in their homes.

But the Mastersound Difference is currently being appreciated by music lovers who don't know a component from a console. Everyone may not understand (or care) why Mastersound recordings sound as good as they do. But anyone who wants the luxury of records and cassettes that sound closer to the real thing can now reap the rewards of Mastersound.

DIGITAL MASTERSOUND RECORDINGS take you closer to live, concert hall sound than the recording process ever could. And, like all Mastersound recordings, no special equipment is necessary for you to hear the spectacular results. All of the sophisticated technology happens in the studio.

The digital recording process is complicated. Very roughly speaking, musical sound is broken down into "digits" that can be stored on tape, and later translated back into musical sound by a computer...with computer accuracy. Since the computer reads the digits...not the tape...many of the problems of conventional tape recording are overcome. For example, tape hiss is inaudible...no "noise reduction" system is necessary. Also, loud passages cannot result in increased distortion...the computer simply compensates for the added complexity by using more digits.

So it becomes possible to record louder, loud sounds (no distortion!) and softer, soft sounds (no tape hiss!) without having to "even out" (compress) the full, natural dynamics of music. Digitally recorded music sounds less constricted. Less like a "record." More like "live."

At this time, digital recordings are more expensive to record, edit and manufacture. But more recording artists and music lovers are getting spoiled by the "digital difference" every day, and digital recording appears to be the wave of the future for everyone.

MASTERSOUND HALF-SPEED MASTERED RECORDINGS preserve more of the original studio master tape sound...including accurate bass and more high end "air"...than conventionally mastered recordings. With the master tape and cutting machine running at half normal speed, every nuance of sound can be more accurately etched. Furthermore, the reduced load on the cutting head and power amplifiers results in sound that is measurably and audibly cleaner and more distortion-free. This more expensive, more time-consuming technique cannot be profitably used for mastering mass produced records. It is used exclusively for Mastersound discs, along with the most advanced cutting system in the industry, the CBS DisComputer. The DisComputer allows all that added signal to be cut onto a disc with no loss in volume. Further along in the pressing process, a new, more time-consuming procedure is used that allows discs to "set" longer before being removed from the press. This, together with a new vinyl compound, and a visual inspection of every single Mastersound disc, makes flat, quieter pressings possible in the U.S. for the first time in over 20 years.

MASTERSOUND CASSETTES preserve all the advantages of digital recording...wide dynamic range...inaudible distortion in complex passages...virtually inaudible tape hiss in low passages. And the cassette equivalent of Half-Speed Mastered LP's have a sound unheard of outside the recording studio. CBS Mastersound cassettes are duplicated at one-quarter the usual duplicating speed onto true Chromium Dioxide tape. Special care is taken at every stage to insure the Dolby and Chrome equalization are exactly right. The tape itself is inspected both before and after it is loaded into the screw-type housing...and each individual cassette is inspected before it leaves the factory. You're assured that the cassette you buy will be a true, crisp mirror of the original performance.
