Be it remembered, that Edgar Bell Siddall then residing at number 1st St school Street, City of Camp Lee, Virginia, State Territory of Australia, who previous to his naturalization was a subject of Australia, having applied to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America pursuant to law, and, at a Court of Prince George County, held at Prince George Co, on the 19 day of JULY, 1918, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and 18, the court having found that the petitioner had resided continuously within the United States ~~for at least five years and in this State for at least one year~~ immediately preceding the date of the filing of his petition, and that said petitioner intends to reside permanently in the United States, had in all respects complied with the law in relation thereto, and that he was entitled to be so admitted, it was thereupon ordered by the said court that he be admitted as a citizen of the United States of America.
